Program Spotlight: Individual Placement and Support (IPS)

Heritage provides support to those engaged in treatment at Heritage and need assistance locating and/or maintaining employment. Below is from an interview with a person-served in the program:

Over the last year, how has life changed for you?

“This time last year I was in crisis about to go to Dove because I had nowhere to live. I was in a toxic relationship and was in really low place. I had lost everything I ever wanted and was holding signs on the corner of the street to get money for drugs. I feel good about myself now.

I wanted help getting a job and was told about the program. It sounded like a good idea and so I said let’s do this. I worked with Angie and we found places for me apply for a job. I applied at Residence Inn and got a phone call to get an interview. Two days later, Angie took me to the interview and I walked out with a job...I have good friends, I’m happy with where I’m at, and where I’m going from here. The cycle has stopped with me”.

What advice would you give to someone starting the IPS program?

“It’s an amazing program and they will help you get to work if you give it a chance. Good things happen when you start to do things for yourself and the future looks promising. You can do it if you put your mind to it.”
